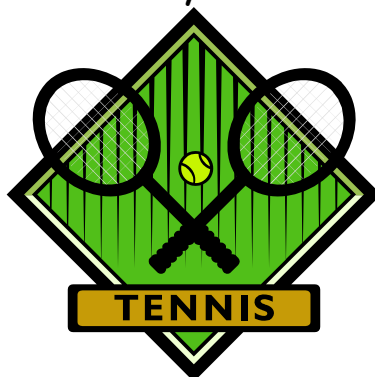


The Neighborhood Club Tennis Newsletter

The Neighborhood Club Tennis Committee welcomes you to the 2010 tennis season, which will officially begin on Saturday, May 1st, with the 2nd as a rain date.

Before the season begins, an important reminder that ***tennis dues must be paid in full in order to participate in any tennis activities.*** The tennis dues will be included in your May club invoice and need to be received by the bookkeeper before family members may play in lessons, clinics, drop-in round robins, or sign up for court time.

- **Tennis Pro Sam Williams** is returning for his 7th season, offering private lessons and clinics, and managing the pro shop at the club. You can reach him at the club at 617-244-0333 and at tennispro@theneighborhoodclub.org
- **Opening Day** is Saturday May 1st. There will be a kids' program from 10:00 - noon followed by a lunch for all ages and an adult round robin from 1:00-3:00. For new members and interested returning members, there will a brief orientation session at 12:50 to acquaint everyone with the club, the tennis rules and court sign-up procedures.
- Our most **popular programs** will be back. These include Monday women's tennis, Wednesday mixed doubles, and Sunday men's tennis. All are drop-in round robins; Monday and Wednesdays from 6:00 p.m. - dusk and Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00a.m.
- Approximately one **tournament or tennis event** per month will be organized by Sam. These may be tournaments with other clubs as well as games for club members and guests. Check the Tennis Board and club website to get the latest developments.

2010 Costs and Sign-Up

Pro Rates*:

Individual One (1) Hour Private Lesson:	\$65
Semi-Private One (1) Hour	\$35/person
Group (up to 3)	\$25/person
Group (up to 4)	\$20/person

*Lessons must be cancelled at least 24 hours in advance for a refund.

Other Fees:

All Guests must be signed in. This includes children's guests, nannies and babysitters. A \$10 fee per guest will be billed to your account. Prospective members on the waiting list may take lessons or play as long as they are with a member and signed in as a guest. A \$15 No-Show fee will be charged to you if you sign up for a court but do not play without erasing your name prior to court time.

A Family Tennis membership is required to enable children to participate in tennis activities, as children cannot be tennis members on their own.

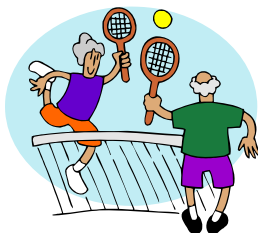

Tennis Rules, in Brief

1. **Tennis Dues** must be paid in advance. Only members and with their regular club and tennis dues paid may use the courts. This includes participation in children's clinics, private lessons, drop-in round robins and court time.
2. **Required footwear is Tennis Shoes with smooth flat soles** which must be worn on the clay courts. Other shoes such as running or cross-trainers can ruin the clay court surface and are expressly prohibited.
3. **Appropriate tennis attire is required** at all times. Shirts must be worn.
4. **Court Sign-up** may only be made two (2) days in advance. Singles is limited to one hour, doubles to one and half hours.
5. **Reserved courts belong to the "reserver" only for ten (10) minutes** after the starting time. Thereafter, the court is open and becomes an unreserved court if the reserver has not arrived.
6. **Sign-up is limited to once per day.** If you would like to play a second time during the same day, you need to do so on a first-come, first-serve basis.
7. **Children of members** under 14 cannot sign up for courts during prime time (weekdays after 5pm and Sat/Sun up to noon), but may play if courts are not being used, and at all other times.
8. **Guests MUST BE SIGNED IN AT ALL TIMES** on the daily sign-up sheet. Simply write down your name legibly and the number of guests on the bottom of the sign-up sheet. The guest fee is \$10 per guest and will be billed to your account.
9. **No-Show fee** of \$15 will be billed to you if you cannot make the time you signed-up for.
10. **NO RIDING** bicycles, tricycles, scooters, skateboards, or other wheeled- recreational vehicles or toys on club grounds.
